





# What is our purpose?

#### Two Success Stories

- Virginia Mason Peer Support Program
  - Originally started when VM reached out to Intergroup
  - PI/CPC & H&T Committees collaborated on follow-up
  - Set up a dedicated email account for peer support requests
  - Continue to regularly dispatch AA volunteers to the hospital



- Recovery Place Beacon Hill Friday night women's meetings
  - Empire Way Tx Rep reached out to the facility
  - Persevered and eventually helped set up weekly women's Zoom meetings, owned by five different groups across various Districts
  - H&T Committee supported with outreach, signal boosting, coordination, and literature
  - Ongoing maintenance now passed on to District 15 Tx Rep
