Minimum Standards for City of Kent Corrections Facility Clearance

1. No conviction or commission of any felony crimes.
2. General misdemeanor convictions are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. However, no convictions for domestic battery, child abuse, stalking, or “peeping Tom” type convictions.
3. No DUI convictions or driver’s license suspensions in the past three years. Withheld judgments will be considered convictions.
4. Must be 18 years of age.
5. Any criminal probation must have been completed. Prospective volunteers cannot be under felony, misdemeanor, or unsupervised probation.
6. No illegal drug use in the past three years; to include no marijuana use in the last year. Use of medical marijuana will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
7. Recovering addicts must have two years of established sobriety.
8. No dishonorable discharges from any U.S. military force.
