## Minimum Standards for City of Kent Corrections Facility Clearance

- 1. No conviction or commission of any felony crimes.
- 2. General misdemeanor convictions are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. However, no convictions for domestic battery, child abuse, stalking, or "peeping Tom" type convictions.
- 3. No DUI convictions or driver's license suspensions in the past three years. Withheld judgments will be considered convictions.
- 4. Must be 18 years of age.
- 5. Any criminal probation must have been completed. Prospective volunteers cannot be under felony, misdemeanor, or unsupervised probation.
- 6. No illegal drug use in the past three years; to include no marijuana use in the last year. Use of medical marijuana will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- 7. Recovering addicts must have two years of established sobriety.
- 8. No dishonorable discharges from any U.S. military force.
